Research and development

- Continue to develop the CAMELOT tool for assessing methodological limitations for use with <u>GRADE CERQual</u>.
- Collectively and individually, we continue to produce relevant methodological research on qualitative evidence synthesis methods of specific interest.
- Currently developing PRISMA for QES having registered an interest on the <u>EQUATOR network</u> site.



Best practice and guidance

- Developed guidance contained in 21 new chapters in the Cochrane Campbell Handbook for Qualitative Evidence Synthesis.
- Delivered a very well attended <u>Cochrane Webinar series on qualitative evidence synthesis</u> in 2021.
- Developed an <u>introductory training module</u> with the Cochrane Training team.
